CALL FOR THE APPLICATION FOR THE TAKING OF WATER FROM THE GREATER BRANDVLEI DAM GOVERNMENT WATER SCHEME.

Applications for water use licences in terms of Section 40 of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act 36 of 1998) can be made by applicants applying for up to 300 000 m³/a of water.

Applicants must be within the reach of the Breede River and within the boundaries of the Central Breede River Water Users Association. (I.e., downstream of the Nekkies bridge to the Zandriff offtake weir near Bonnievale) to be able to be considered for this water.

All aspiring applicants **must make a pre-application** in an executive summary indicating the intended application for the applied use. The BOCMA will provide suitable applicants with assistance, where necessary, to use the on-line e-WULAAAS licensing platform that facilitates the process.

All applicants shall be subjected to a verification process that includes, but is not limited to:

- 1. Only one (1) application per applicant will be considered.**
- 2. A letter from the relevant Water Users Association supporting the application,**
- 3. Proof of paid-up accounts with the relevant Water Users Association and / or the BOCMA (where relevant)**
- Validated and Verified water use for the property applying for the water (Section 35 of the National Water Act 1998, (Act 36 of 1998).
- Proof of ownership of land,
- Proof of relevant long-term lease agreements for land,
- Clear indication on the intended use of the water (crops, industry etc.)
- The socio-economic impact of the water use / uses with special efforts towards redress of previously Disadvantaged Individuals.
- Ability to utilise the water in an effective and efficient way.

Applications that would include possible illegal developments (i.e., illegal dams and/or enlargements, unauthorised abstraction from groundwater or surface water sources) will not be considered without the final decision made by the relevant authorities.

It will be compulsory that all successful licensees' become members of the Central Breede River Water User Association and the associated infrastructure and management costs levied by them.

This call for applications is in **addition** to the call for applicants that are 30% (Minimum) black owned enterprises and partnerships for volumes of water between 372 500 m³ /and 745 000 m³ /a (between 50ha and 100 hectares of irrigation); AND 51% (minimum) black owned enterprises and partnership for volumes of more than 745 000 m³ /a (more than 100 hectares

of irrigation).
